

ADSI Awarded CMMS Contract for School District of Philadelphia

ADSI also provided hosting and support of the integrated system so that the District did not have to dedicate internal resources to maintain and manage the system. On September 23, 2013, the School Reform Commission (SRC) selected ADSI as the vendor. The implementation of this system will take place in 2013 and 2014, with ongoing support services through 2017.

Currently the building automation systems, energy information management systems and the CMMS systems all provide valuable information and functionality but are not connected into a comprehensive solution. With the integrated system The School District will obtain a process that will automate the sharing of information between the systems and significantly shorten the time between the occurrence of a problem and the dispatch of a technician to remedy the situation, thus reducing cost. By using GIS technology to calculate the most efficient routing for maintenance vehicles, the District will realize reduced fuel costs and faster response time.

“Any facility management professional that needs to assess a campus, operate or manage more than one building at a time, or needs to manage assets that are spread out over a
